THE AWESOME ANIMALS SUMMER PROGRAM



For twelve years The Awesome Animals Summer Program has been teaching children about animals and nature through hands-on activities, educational experiments, exciting demonstrations, and of course live animals! From chickens, rabbits, frogs, pigeons, snakes, and even hedgehogs and salamanders, the Awesome Animal Summer Program is a fascinating introduction to the animals of world. The program is divided into two classes:

Awesome Animals (PreK to 3rd grade) – In Awesome Animals, children are introduced to and interact with new and different animals each day (only the safe animals of course). The instructors introduce the animals through anatomy, defense mechanisms, diet, habitat, and social behavior. The students further their animal knowledge with hands-on projects, activities, and games. The children also have worksheets and tons of hands on activities and projects each day, not to mention snack time where the kids learn to eat like frogs or rabbits. On the last day of class each child gets a pet of their own, a betta fish (aka Siamese Fighting Fish), with a small tank and all the supplies needed. The goal of the program is to teach children just how wonderful animals are and how important it is to treat them with respect and protect their natural habitats.

Advanced Awesome Animals (3rd to 6th grade) – This class is for aspiring veterinarians, biologists, zookeepers, or simply kids that want to learn more than just the basics about animals. Just like the regular Awesome Animals class, we use live animals to learn from. However, in this class, children learn about environmental protection, zoos exhibit design, beginning animal medical care, local wildlife, animal training techniques, and much more. Students in this class will also assemble a notebook of information they learned. This class even includes an optional Sunday field trip to a local pet store for a behind the scenes look at how pet stores work. At the end of the class students receive their own pet betta fish, mini tank, and supplies. This is the perfect class for Awesome Animal Alumni.
